GUIDELINES

1. **This contest is free and open to Prince William County residents in grades 9-12.** (Immediate family members of KPWB staff, Board of Directors, or Interns are not eligible.) Overall winner will receive a \$500 scholarship; second prize winner will receive \$350, and third prize winner will receive \$150. Honorable mentions will receive a certificate.
2. **Artwork must be student's original work.** If using a photo model taken by someone else, image must be significantly altered to avoid plagiarism. Artwork should not be traced from another artist's work, and **no hands other than the student's own should be involved in the creation of the artwork. Artwork may not exceed 11 x 14 inches in size.** Acceptable media are pencil, markers, ink, crayon, chalk or pastel (fixed), watercolor, paint, fiber, photography, and collage. Three-dimensional pieces, printouts, or photocopies are not eligible.
3. Attach to the back of each piece of artwork, a completed Entry Form and a short statement (50 word minimum) about your inspiration and how the artwork reflects "Protecting Our Pollinators". Please do not fold artwork or use staples.
4. Through submission of artwork, contestants and their legal guardians grant to the KPWB non-exclusive reproduction and publication rights to the works submitted. No submitted entry will be returned, KPWB will retain ownership.
5. All entries must be postmarked by April 1, 2019. Students may enter multiple pieces. Multiple entries (whether from one student or from a group) can be sent in one package, however each entry must have its own entry form and entry fee attached. KPWB is not responsible for entries that are late, damaged, or lost. Entries will be judged by KPWB's Board of Directors. Winners will be contacted directly and also announced at www.kpwb.org by April 15, 2019.
